

The Role of PA NEN's Board

1. The primary role of the Board is to provide guidance in setting the goals, strategies and direction for PA NEN.
2. The Board is engaged in the pursuit and use of SNAP-Ed funds in collaboration with appropriate partners.
3. Guide and enforce implementation of the strategic plan.
4. Provide direction and resources for the Network that will advance PA NEN goals.
5. Recreate the Strategic Committee when necessary.
6. Provides updates to PA NEN members that affect the membership at large.
7. Reviews and approves the annual Action Plans of PA NEN Committees.
8. Meet quarterly. One meeting may coincide with the Annual Business Meeting of the PA NEN. At least two of the meetings shall be face-to-face meetings.
9. Special meetings of the Board may be called by the PA NEN Board Chair.
10. Board members are expected to attend meetings regularly.
11. Board members are responsible for the oversight of the PA NEN Executive Director
